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— DETAILED ASSESSMENT OF LANGUAGE SKILLS —



The person has an advanced level of linguistic and grammar knowledge, which is used in various situations. They recognise and apply in context complex grammar structures, make a few mistakes which do not impair communication in any way.



The person has an advanced level of lexical knowledge. They show a wide range of lexical knowledge, which is used in various situations. They recognise and apply in context complex lexical constructions, more complex phrases and idiomatic expressions, both in terms of general and job-related language. They make just a few mistakes.



The audited person can produce detailed texts such as essays, reports and letters, and is able to present arguments effectively. The piece of writing sticks to the topic and includes all the required information. They show the knowledge of grammar and vocabulary typical for an independent user. They make use of rich general and work-related vocabulary. They use longer and more complex sentences that are easy to understand. The text is coherent and logical. They use appropriate style, adapted to a given situation and potential recipients. They use the form and register typical for email correspondence. The layout is appropriate with individual parts accordingly separated. The person is communicative and easy with writing. In general, the piece of writing is interesting and nice to read. However, they make few mistakes, e.g., pana vs. Pana; sposōb vs. sposób; oczwiście vs. oczywiście; dydpozycji vs. dyspozycji; zaorganizować vs. zorganizować (orthography), uważa vs. pilnuje; ta praca jest bardzo sensytywna (lexis); jest śledzić vs. jest śledzenie (grammar). Mistakes do not impact the understanding of the content.



The audited person can convey ideas relatively fluently and spontaneously and actively participate in discussions. The auditee understood most of the questions and answered all of them. The audited person answers with full and longer sentences. Replies are coherent and logical. They show the knowledge of grammar typical for an independent user. The audited person correctly selects grammatical structures. The speaker makes use of general and work-related vocabulary range. The person uses synonyms and idiomatic expressions. The language of the utterance is complex. The accent and pronunciation are correct. The pace of speech is adequate. However, two of the answers partially are off-topic. They make few mistakes, e.g., skulptur; player (lexis), z śmietaną vs. ze śmietaną; czego lubilem vs. co lubilem (grammar). Mistakes do not impede overall communication.

— RECOMMENDATION TO FURTHER LEARNING —

The audited person is an upper-intermediate user of the language. It would be advised to keep on practicing the language in order to perfect their skills.
